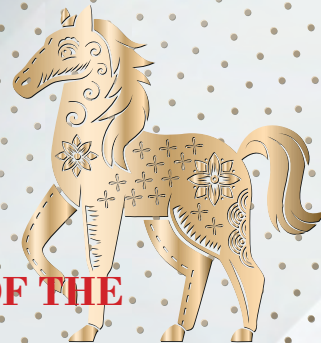

The Qingming festival

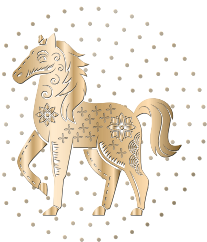

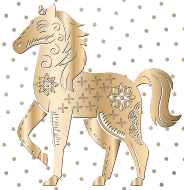

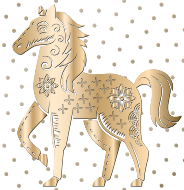
